Application

The Altecnic 303615 double check valve with isolating ball valve is used to prevent the risk of backflow and back siphonage contamination in domestic dwellings, public and commercial buildings.

The valve should be installed close to the water outlet such as taps, basin taps, showers and toilets to prevent back siphonage contamination to the water supply, should a mains supply pipe burst.

The integral ball valve can act as a service valve to isolate the water outlet should maintenance or replacement be required in the future.

The Altecnic 303615 double check valve with isolating valve can be used as part of a filling loop to fill and pressurise central heating systems or as part of a sealed system kit for unvented heating systems.

Design

The 303615 double check valve complies with BS EN 13959 'Antipollution check valves' family E, type D - non controllable.

The 303615 non verifiable double check valve is manufactured from DZR copper alloy with a nickel plated finish, to enhance the appearance for exposed installations.

The valve provides category 3 protection for both backflow and back siphonage as specified in the Water Supply (Water Fittings) Regulations 1999.

Supplied with an integral test point for monitoring the function of the downstream check valve.


The valves are designed for high flow rates with minimum pressure

Supplied with compression ends complying with BS EN 1252-2 for use with R250 (half hard) copper tube or female taper threads complying with BS EN 10226-2.
